

## Ooredoo Palestine reported strong Net Profit growth of 28% reaching USD 15.1 million

Ramallah, Palestine, 8<sup>th</sup> February 2026: Wataniya Palestine Mobile Telecommunications Public Shareholding Company ("Ooredoo") - Ticker: "OORED00" at the Palestine Exchange, today announced its financial results for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025.

### Operational Highlights:

- Revenue for the year ended 31 December 2025 stood at USD 106.2 million in 2025, compared to USD 109.0 million for the same period in 2024, impacted by the challenging operating environment.
- EBITDA for the year ended 31 December 2025 increased by 2% to reach USD 40.8 million (compared to 40.0 million for the same period in 2024), reflecting a 2% increase with a corresponding EBITDA margin of 38%. EBITDA was impacted by the ongoing on-the-ground circumstances. Despite the decline in revenue of USD 2.8 million, EBITDA increased by USD 0.8 million, supported by continued efforts in cost optimization and operational efficiency.
- Net Profit for the year ended 31 December 2025 increased by 28%, reaching USD 15.1 million compared to USD 11.8 million in 2024, supported mainly by the lower operating expenses.
- The customer base for the year ended 31 December 2025 declined by 4% to 1.49 million.



Dr. Samer Fares, Chief Executive Officer of Ooredoo Palestine commented:

“We are pleased to report that 2025 was another successful year for Ooredoo Palestine, delivering a resilient financial and operational performance despite an extraordinarily challenging operating environment. Our results reflect the strength of our strategy, supported by continued digital innovation and a disciplined focus on efficiency.

For the year, EBITDA increased by 2% to reach USD 40.8 million, while Net Profit grew by an impressive 28% to just over USD 15 million, underscoring our ability to navigate uncertainty while sustaining profitability.

Looking ahead, we will continue to execute with resilience and discipline, advancing our digital innovation agenda and investing in mission-critical infrastructure to support long-term growth. We remain focused on delivering sustainable shareholder value through improved operational efficiency and a stronger competitive position. At the same time, we are committed to advancing our ESG priorities, supporting the communities we serve, and contributing meaningfully to the development of the Palestinian economy.
