



Ooredoo Palestine announced Net Profit of USD 10 million for the first nine-months of 2021

Revenue increased by 13%

Ramallah, Palestine, 31 Oct 2021: Wataniya Palestine Mobile Telecommunications Public Shareholding Company ("Ooredoo") - Ticker: "OOREDOO" at the Palestine Exchange, today announced its financial results for the nine months ended 30 Sep 2021.

Operational Highlights:

- Revenues increased by 13% for the first nine months of 2021 to USD 84.8 million, compared with USD 75.2 million for the same period in 2020
- EBITDA increased by 22% for the first nine months of 2021 to USD 30.7 million, EBITDA margin improved from 33% to 36% due to further improvements in operational performance
- 9M Net Profit increased significantly to reach USD 9.9 million, representing a strong growth of 68% compared to USD 5.9 million for the same period in 2020. The growth was driven by operational performance and revenue growth
- Customer base increased by 3% to reach more than 1.3 million at the end of September 2021.

Dr. Durgham Maraee, Chief Executive Officer of Ooredoo Palestine commented:

"I am pleased to report a robust set of results during the first nine months of 2021 with Net Profit increasing 68% to USD 9.9 million, driven by Revenue growing 13% to USD 84.8 million, with an improvement in EBITDA by 22% to USD 30.7 million. Ooredoo Palestine continues to perform well despite
